#### PET OWNERS & PUBLIC PARKS

#### MH-4-1200. - SPECIFIC REGULATIONS.

The following rules and regulations apply to all public parks except as otherwise stated.

- i) Animals. No person shall bring into a park any animal other than dogs or cats except as hereafter specifically provided or as otherwise permitted by the General Manager. Persons in charge of dogs and cats are responsible for the immediate removal and proper disposal of all dog or cat waste.
- (j) **Dogs.** Dogs shall be licensed. No person may bring and maintain in any park more than two (2) dogs except with the written permission of the General Manager and the dog(s) shall be kept on a *leash* or chain not to exceed six (6) feet in length, and under the immediate control of its owner or custodian. Dogs are not permitted on golf courses. Upon the posting of signs, the General Manager may designate areas in which dogs are permitted without a *leash* or chain.
