Nixle is a community notification system designed to notify Mountain House residents of public safety emergency alerts, advisories, and notices. Nixle uses both email and SMS messaging to reach residents with important information. Nixle is only to be used for the notification of Public Safety alerts and advisories. UPCOMING MH FLAG FOOTBALL ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS

At the end of April, MH Golf Club (a division of MH Flag Football) has its second tournament of the year at Shadow Lakes in Brentwood. This will be the first time the club will be playing there.

On May 3, our nonprofit, Mountain House Flag Football (MHFF), will be presenting "A Royal Affair," an event for all the little princesses in MH. 100% of the proceeds of this event will be used to make our MH Youth Cheer program even better this year.

The weekend of May 10-11 will be the 4th annual MH Tennis Club (a division of MH Flag Football) tournament at Central Park. This year, for the first time, the tournament will be open to kids.

On May 25th, the MH Golf Club will be having its third tournament of the year at Diablo Grande in Patterson. One of the most challenging courses is also one of the most beautiful.

We wrap up the spring with the second annual MH Kite Run. Last year, MHFF with volunteers from the MH Runners Club, organized and directed the largest race in the history of MH. We increased the number of runners in the 5K/10K from a previous high of 187 to 430 last year. We even had over 100 kids in the biggest Fun Run ever.
