Bike lanes in Great Valley Parkway, Arturo Blvd., Main St.

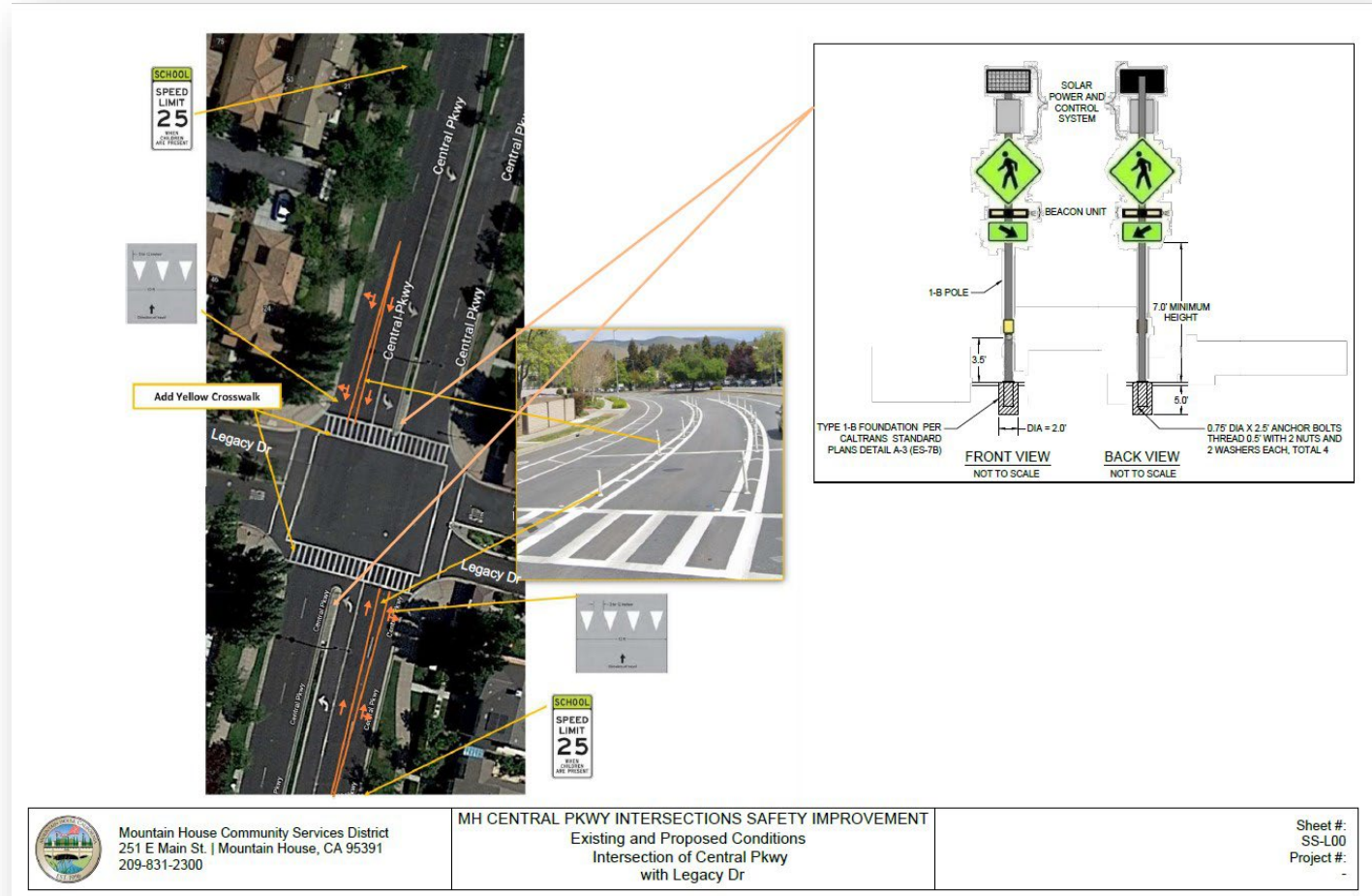
- Grants Awarded by Highway Safety Improvement Program-Caltrans
- Estimated cost of Construction \$662,000
- Grant Awarded \$249,930.
- Grants should be awarded through the County
- Working with the County



Update about Grants Awarded

Traffic Safety Improvements on Central Parkway at Legacy and Heritage Drive.

- Grants Awarded by Highway Safety Improvement Program-Caltrans
- Estimated cost of Construction \$151,000
- Grant Awarded \$135,900 (90%)
- Grants should be awarded through the County
- Working with the County

Public Works Project Updates

- Traffic Signal Synchronization project design is 100% complete.
- Estimated Cost: \$240,000
- Traffic Safety modification
- Pavement Repairs on Byron Road, Bethany Road, Wicklund Village Starts on August 21



Mountain House Map

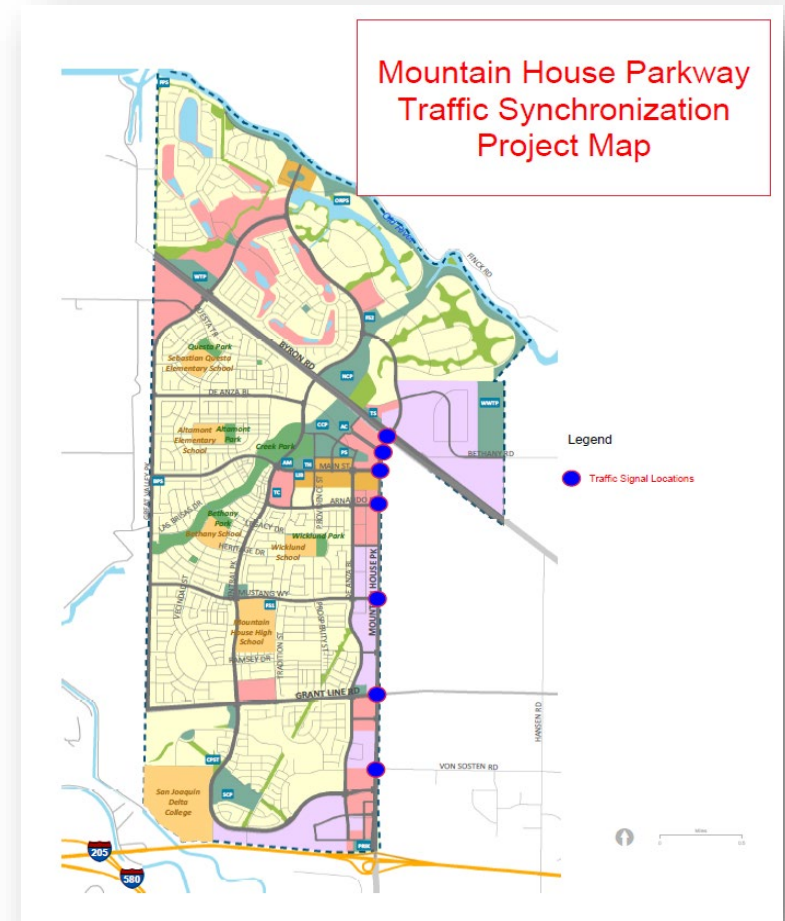
Traffic Signal Synchronization

Project Locations:

- Mountain House Pkwy from Von Sosten Road to Byron Rd.

Status:

- In Design Phase. 100% Design is complete.
- Design documents must be approved by Caltrans for authorization to bid the project
- Need to Prepare a Bid Package for Construction



Byron Road, Bethany Road, and Wicklund Village Pavement Repairs

Project Locations (Byron Road):

- 2" AC grinding and Overlay (77,000 sq-ft).
- Striping

Project Locations (Bethany Road):

- 3" AC grinding and Overlay (28,000 sq-ft)
- Striping

Project Location (Wicklund Village):

- Crack Seal (60,000 feet)

Anticipated Start and Completion Date:

- Starts on August 21, 2023
- Completion on September 29, 2023

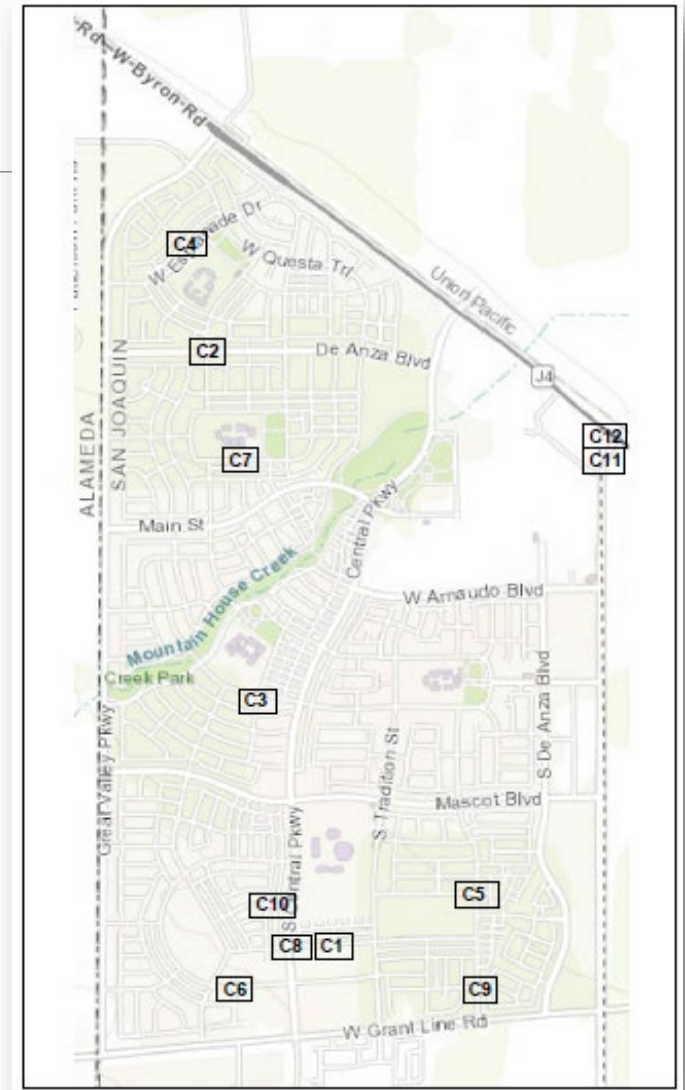

- C1: Ramsey Drive, Central to Tradition
- C2: Arturo Blvd., at Montebello St.
- C3: Comunidad St., Heritage Dr. to Verano Way
- C4: Esplanade Dr. at Riatta Ranch Dr.
- C5: Prosperity St. at Parco Ave.
- C6: Phelps Dr. at Baker St.
- C7: Piedmont Dr. Between Puente Dr. and Aldea St.
- C8: Central Parkway at Ramsey Dr.
- C10: Shields at Fremont St.
- C11 & C12: Mountain House Parkway and Byron Road

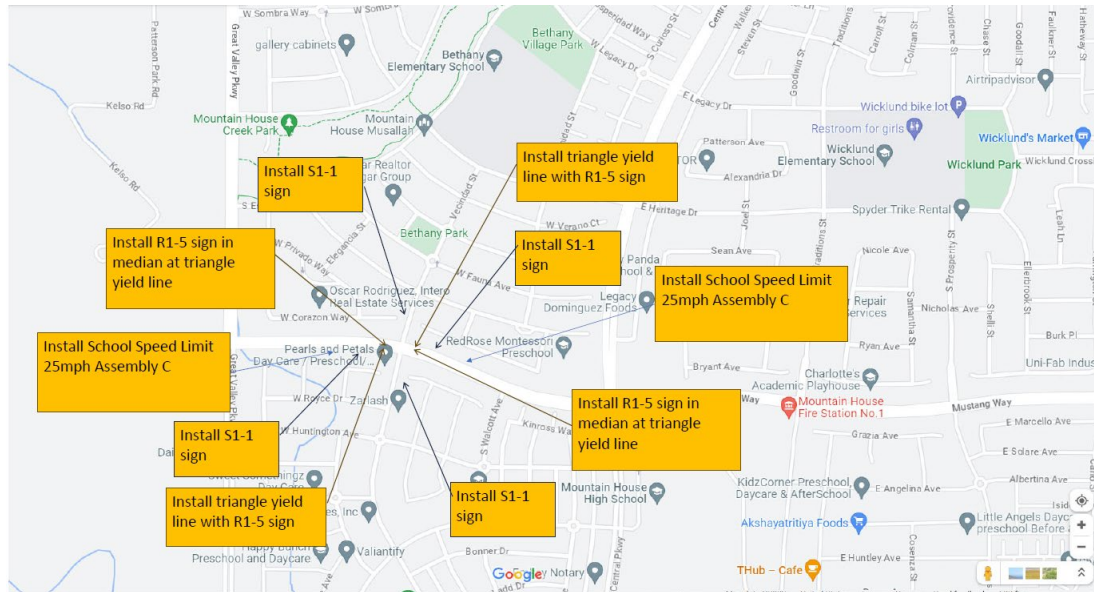

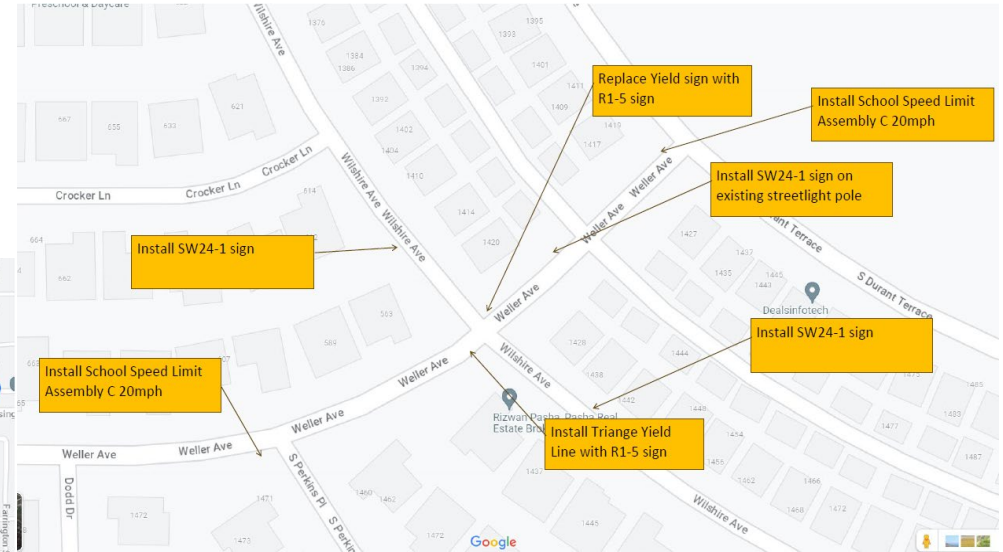

High Visibility Crosswalks and Speed Limit Signs



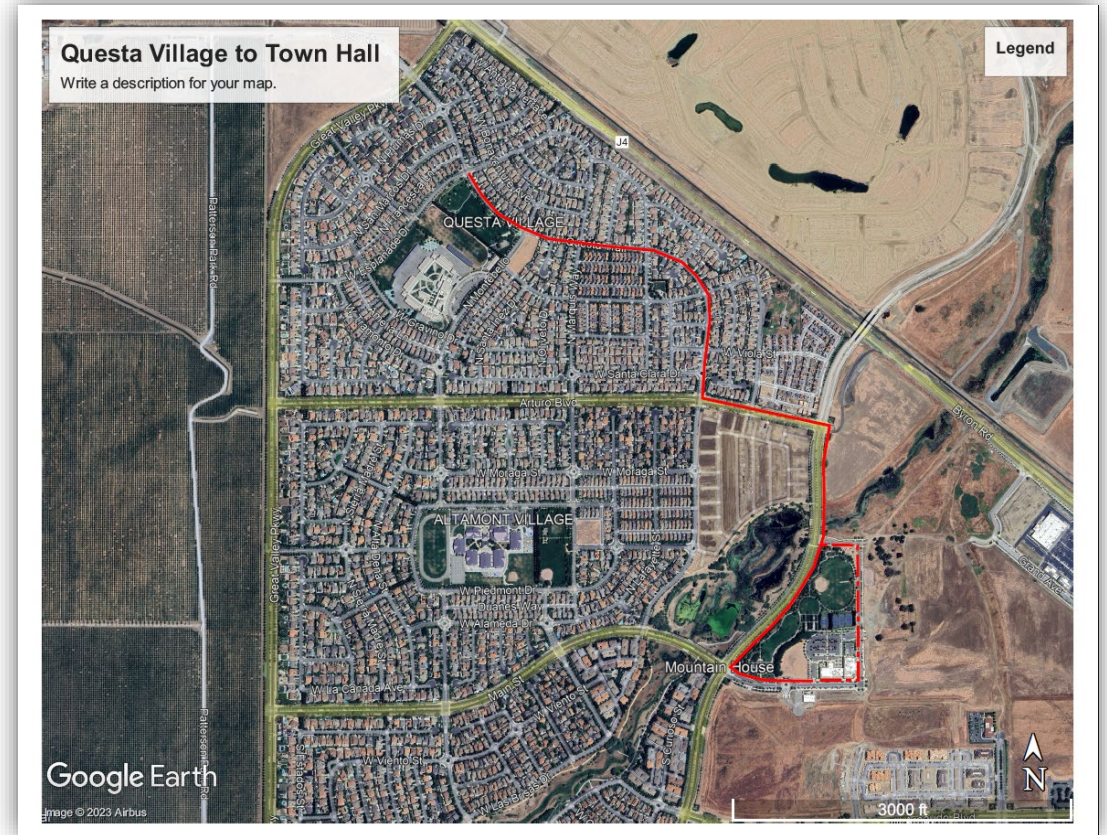
Speed Humps, Signs and Striping

Projects Under Consideration (School District Traffic Safety Requests)



Request for Accessible Pedestrian Signal (APS)

- Requested by a Resident
- Installation of APS at Central Parkway and Main Street
- Caltrans only requires APS and pushbuttons for traffic signals.
- Redlines present a safe route to Town Center
