Dear Community of Mountain House:

We are quickly moving through the year with summer fast approaching. While the northern California snowpack and their downstream reservoirs seem to be faring well, not so for New Melones Reservoir located on the Stanislaus River, groundwater basins around the San Joaquin Valley pumped hard during the drought, and southern San Joaquin Valley and Southern California. Here in Mountain House, I do not expect a repeat of the curtailment experienced in 2015, but the Governor has extended drought regulations through October 15, 2016. For now, the Mountain House Community Services District (MHCSD) Board directed Stage III drought emergency with two-day per week irrigation requirements will still be in effect. Mountain House Community Services District staff will monitor conditions closely and will make appropriate changes as new information becomes available.

Please continue to conserve both indoors and outdoors through the use of smart water tips available online. For those that shut off outdoor irrigation completely last year, please ensure you irrigate at least the allowable two days per week to maintain your landscape vegetation. Remember, multiple, shorter irrigation cycles during the two allowable days is better than one long irrigation cycle – this will help minimize runoff and ensure water gets to the plant's root zone. MHCSD staff is here to help you. If you need help with programming your irrigation controller or would like further information regarding landscape design requirements and how to conserve water, please visit the Mountain House Community Services District website at the following web address: www.mountainhousecsd.org or contact MHCSD staff directly at (209) 831-2300.
